WHEN cafe2u owners Doug and Kerry Kelly hit the streets of Mackay in their mean bean machine two years ago, they were new to the world of coffee.

But their business is steaming ahead, recently being named Queensland's cafe2u franchise of the year.

The mobile cafe was also listed as one of the country's top five cafe2u franchises at an award ceremony in Sydney in January.
